Who we are

Strathglass Marketing Group (SMG) is the community business association that organises the Glen Affric Duathlon. For the purposes of the Data Protection Acts 1998, GDPR, and the Data Protection Bill 2017, the data processor is Jim McAuley, Langside, Cannich, Inverness-shire, IV4 7LT on behalf of SMG.

Information you give us

We collect information about you when you sign-up for an event that we organise such as the Glen Affric Duathlon. Information is collected primarily by Entry Central when you enter the event and we access this to fully process entries. Entry Central have their own Privacy Policy that can read via a link on the Sign Up page(s) on their website.

We also collect information should you choose not to enter online and enter with us directly via email or by post.

Signing-up for an event or membership

We may collect:

- your name and address to identify you personally
- your date of birth and gender to check your eligibility for the event or membership and to assign any applicable event category
- your email address and phone number for sending sign-up email receipts, and in case we need to contact you
- your membership status for applicable sport governing bodies so that we can check your eligibility or appropriately price your sign-up

When you sign up Entry Central displays a list of entrants, using your forename, surname, club name, and event category on their website.

We also display some of your details on the results pages on our website.

SMG does not have access to any financial information e.g. credit/debit card details.

Marketing

Our event is sanctioned by Triathlon Scotland and in accordance with their permit we are obliged to include the following:

‘You agree that we may publish your personal information as part of the results of the event, and will pass such information to any governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of insurance, licences, or the publishing of results, either for the event alone, or combined with, or compared to other events. Results may include, but are not limited to first name, surname, date of birth, age category, result, penalties and any club / home country / regional affiliation.

You also agree that in the event of a disciplinary or welfare incident that you are either involved in or witness, we may pass on your personal information to British Triathlon and/or the relevant Home Nation association or any relevant Authorities for the purpose of supporting any investigatory activity into that incident.’

Triathlon Scotland also request that we present non-affiliated entrants with the option of being contacted by them for marketing purposes. You may choose to opt-in or opt-out on entry form.

We will not share your details for any other marketing purpose.

Cookies

We do not collect any personal information via our website. Cookies are only used for analysis purposes i.e. Google Analytics.

How long we keep your data

We will ordinarily keep your data for 6 months after the event date to allow time for any queries, disputes and accounting activities.
